Jennifer Tremblay

Jennifer Tremblay is a writer and publisher born in 1973 in Quebec. After having published a collection of poems and completed her studies in creative writing at UQAM (1995), she wrote close to one hundred episodes for a children's television program *Les Chatouilles* (Radio-Canada). In 2004, she cofounded the "Éditions de la Bagnole" with Martin Larocque. Afterwards, she published *La Liste* (2007), a dramatic monologue for which she received, in 2008, the Governor General's Award. The play was produced by "Théâtre d'Aujourd'hui" in 2010 and has been performed a hundred times on tour throughout French Canada. Now translated in five languages, published in English, Spanish and Portuguese, and produced in many cities in the world including New York and Capetown, *La Liste* continues its journey. It is followed by *Le Carrousel* (2011) and *La Délivrance* (2014). The three plays form a trilogy called *Mères, trilogie pour une actrice*. Jennifer published her second novel in 2015, *Blues nègre dans une chambre rose*, at "Éditions VLB", after *Tout ce qui brille* published in 2004. Finally, as a publisher, Jennifer has supervised the publication of nearly a hundred albums and novels for children.
